Luminaries to light the way

At the conclusion of the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the altar is stripped and the Blessed Sacrament will be reposed in the Social Hall until Midnight. There will be a Eucharist Procession from the Church to the Social Hall.

Anyone is welcome to make a Luminary to Light the way. Use a one gallon milk jug, cut off the top, use a permanent marker or dry erase crayon to decorate. You can honor a loved one by writing their names on the luminary.

Return your luminary by Palm Sunday to the Faith Formation Office

Materials and Instructions needed for making your own Luminaries:

One Gallon Plastic Milk Jug

2" of Sand* in the Bottom of Each

Knife for cutting jug and a lighter

1. Discard cap
2. Clean out milk jug with soapy water.
3. Soak off the label
4. Leaving the handle, cut out the top section of the jug in a "U" shape
5. Leave plain, decorate the luminary, write the names of loved ones to remember
