St. Vincent de Paul Report to Donors - 2024

The Transfiguration Conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society is grateful to you, our parishioners and friends for your unfailing support. Our outreach, enabled by your contributions and a share of the proceeds from the SVdP Thrift Store in Kennesaw, allows Neighbors in need, regardless of religious affiliation, to meet short-term emergencies, including rent, utilities and transportation, with dignity.

The following is a summary of SVdP financial activity during 2024:

Total Receipts **\$441,775***

Total Disbursements **\$419,084**

*In addition, in September we were blessed to receive a \$100,000 bequest, designated for food outreach.

Total disbursements include \$243,400 for rent and temporary lodging. As our area is experiencing a critical shortage of affordable housing, this assistance has been a lifeline for many.

Our help is more than financial. Parishioners' in-kind donations of groceries and prepared meals help diminish food insecurity among our Neighbors and others in the community. We also team with other community groups to provide additional help for those we serve.
