What is Alpha?

Alpha is an opportunity for an encounter with Christ. It is an 8-week course, meeting weekly, 90-minute sessions, from the week of September 6- the week of November 8.

At the Alpha sessions, enjoy a meal, view a short video that encourages conversations, and explore questions about our Christian faith and its relevance to daily life. Alpha empowers each of us to live out our unique callings and gifts from the Holy Spirit. (Please note, all sessions provide a gluten free option with salad and grilled chicken or other items. Menu will be posted weekly on our website.)

When does Alpha meet?

There are 12 Alpha course sessions to choose from.

Our Great Journey, our parish Faith Formation program, with sessions designed to enrich the Catholic faith of every member of our parish family, will resume bi-weekly beginning November 2. Alpha will open the first 8 weeks of Our Great Journey sessions.

Sessions are offered for preschool through adults.
