

## St. Vincent de Paul Report to Donors - 2025

The Transfiguration Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul is grateful to you, our parishioners and friends for your unfailing support. Our outreach allows Neighbors in need, regardless of religious affiliation, to meet short-term emergencies including rent, utilities, food, and transportation, with dignity.

Here's a summary of 2025 SVdP financial activity:

**Total Receipts: \$458,300** (from individual contributions and a portion of the proceeds from the SVdP Thrift Store in Kennesaw)

**Total Disbursements: \$474,443** (includes \$238,195 for rent and temporary lodging. Due to a shortage of affordable housing, this assistance has been a lifeline for many.)

The excess of Disbursements over Receipts was funded by cash reserves.

Our help is more than financial. Parishioners' in-kind donations of groceries and prepared meals help diminish food insecurity among our Neighbors and others in the community. We also team with other community groups to provide additional help for those we serve.

**1,178** Bags of survival essentials distributed to Homeless individuals

**7,597** SVdP-prepared meals served at MUST, Women's Extension, and Homeless outreach ministries

**13,800** Volunteer hours in service of SVdP outreach
